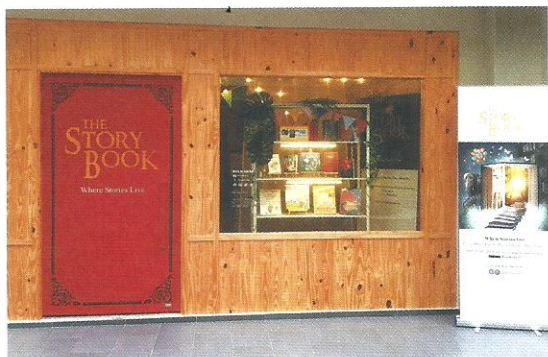

Fitness Fix

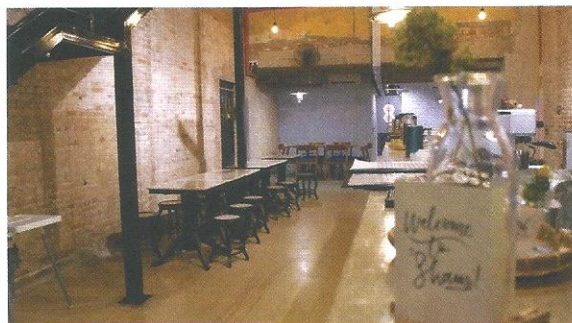
